because Bharata's own brothers have not submitted.

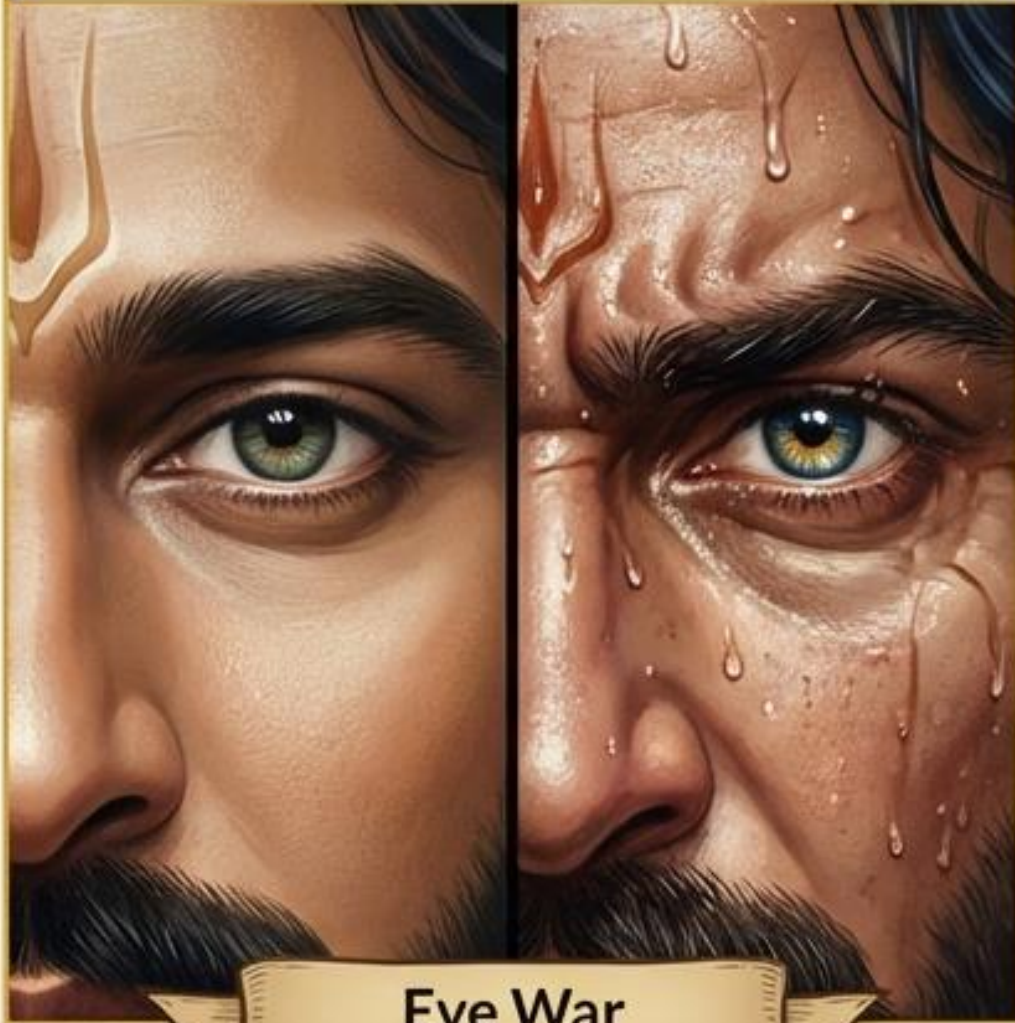
THE FALLOUT.

Only Bahubali stands his ground, refusing to bow.

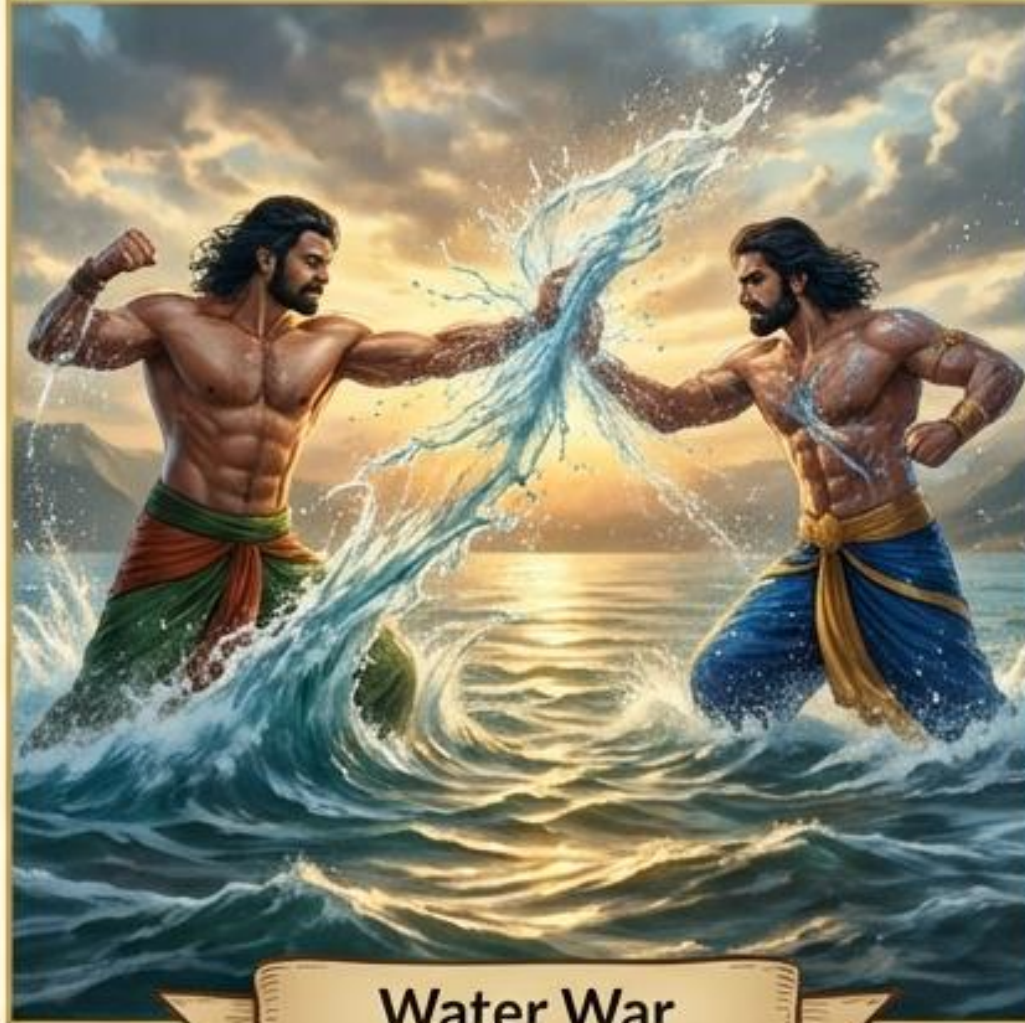
THE WAR OF SOVEREIGNS: DHARMAYUDDHA

DRISHTI YUDDHA (EYE WAR)



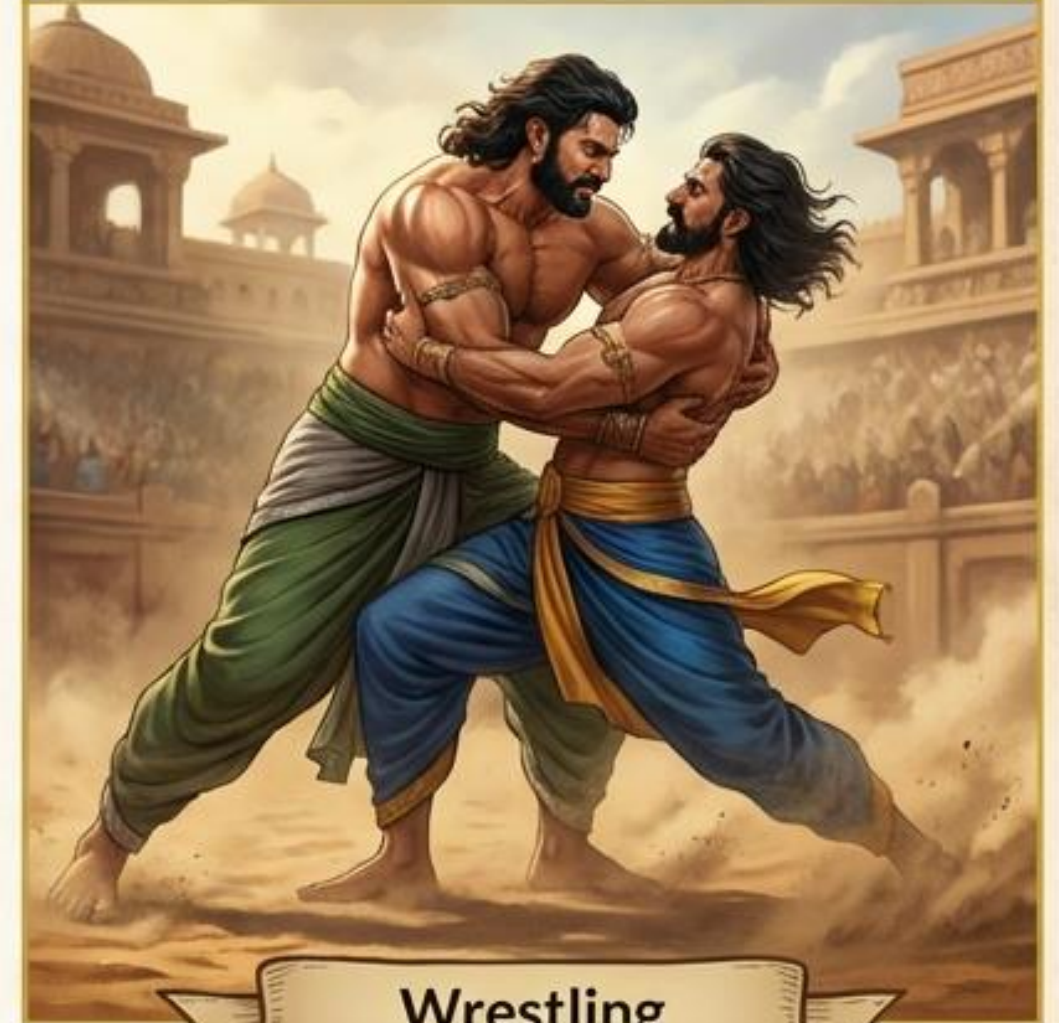
Eye War

THE MOMENT OF AWAKENING

He releases Bharata and renounces his kingdom on the spot.

THE PENANCE OF BAHUBALI

He stood motionless for one year. His omniscience was blocked only by a sliver of residual ego—regret for humiliating his brother.



When Bharata finally arrived to worship him, the last shackle broke. Bahubali attained *Moksha*, becoming the first liberated soul of the era.

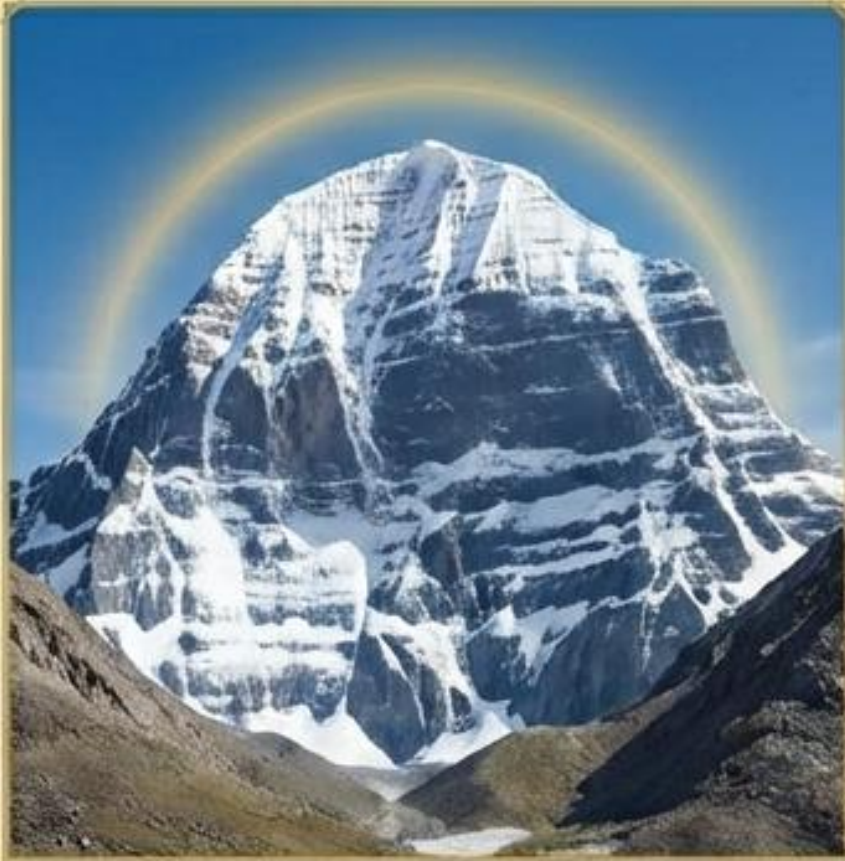

The rivalry was not an accident. It was a karmic knot tied over centuries, finally untied through liberation.

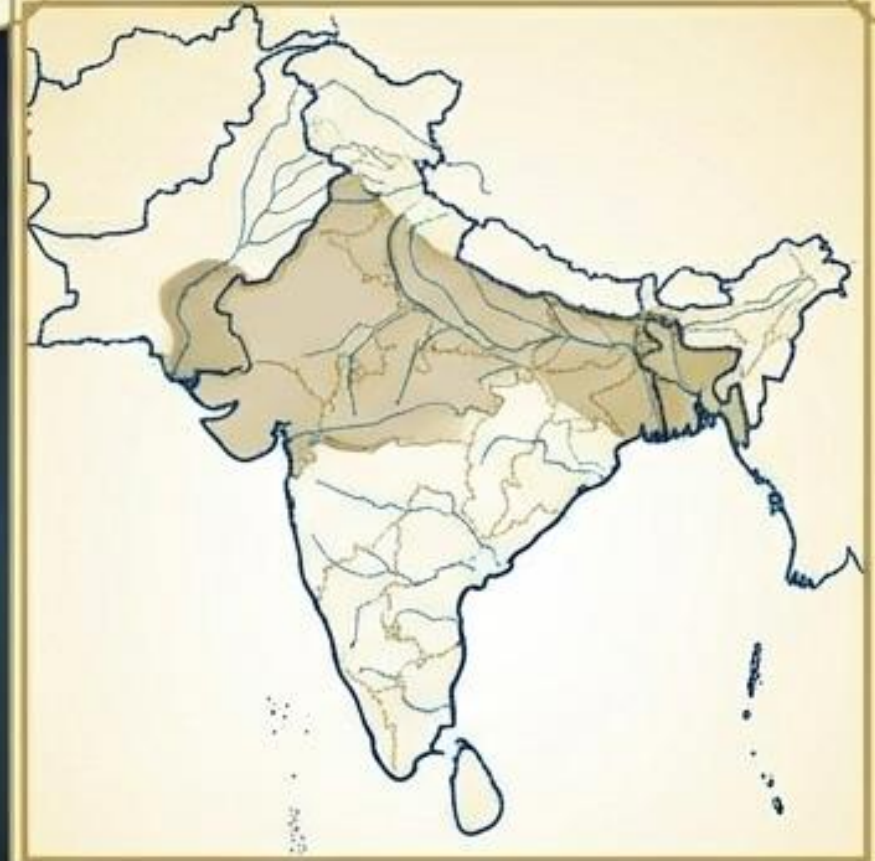
A LEGACY WRITTEN IN STONE
